

January 2, 2014
Public Hearing

Public hearing began at 6:35 p.m. The purpose for the hearing was to receive public comment on the Town's proposal to apply for funding from the Utah Permanent Community Impact Fund Board (CIB) to construct restrooms at the Boulder Town Park.

Present: Bill Muse, Mayor; Gladys LeFevre, Tom Jerome, Sue Inman, Steve Cox,
Council Members; Judi Davis, Clerk.

Public Present: Cindy Wilson, Ashley Coombs, Bob and Chyleen Mackey.

The Town is planning to apply to the CIB for a \$47,000 grant which we will match with \$5,000 for the purpose of building restrooms at the tract park. We have asked Jones & DeMille Engineering to help with the engineering and cost projection. Their fees will not exceed \$3,000.

The Mayor stated that, while a request for funding may be made to the PCIFB for a grant to fund a particular project, the CIB Board may instead offer to the Town the funding in the form of an interest-bearing loan which would require repayment.

Gladys read the paragraph from a letter from Jones & DeMille which outlines the scope of work they propose to do for us. Bill explained that they are trying to keep the project within the \$52,000 budget. Sam has estimated that the trench to get water and power to the pavilion and restroom sites will cost \$1,100. We will get an estimate from Garkane on the cost of the power lines and meter.

Steve wondered if the proposal to design restrooms with one stall in each side instead of the two we hoped to have was a result of their projection of costs or need. We believe it is a result of what is possible within the budget.

Chyleen asked if we will have money to take care of restrooms once they are built. We have considered that and are planning to budget for a maintenance person once the restrooms are finished. We will soon have to hire a maintenance person to do maintenance of all the town facilities, as the need is becoming greater with each new facility.

There were no more public comments, and the public hearing was closed at 6:50 p.m.
