Public Hearings

1. Package Liquor Store

Public Present: Keri Venuti, Donna Owen, Darren Logan, Amber Thompson, Ashley Coombs.

The public hearing was opened at 6:32. Donna read a letter which 153 people (101 of whom were local) signed in support of having a liquor store in Boulder. The format of the letter was not “for or against,” but two signers were opposed. She thinks a package liquor agency would be a good thing for the community.

Darren stated that, while he was working at Hills & Hollows, a great many people who were staying in town came to the store and asked for wine. He thinks it would be a great service to those people.

Keri stated that it would be helpful to the restaurants who serve alcohol with meals to be able to pick up the alcohol here.

Constance Lynn and Matt Cochran each submitted the written comment that they are opposed to having a liquor store in Boulder.

Gladys has had a few people contact her who were opposed. She appreciates the input of citizens, whether they are for or against it.

There were no more comments, and the public hearing was closed. The second public hearing followed, with the same people present.

2. Ordinance 2017-1

Amending the Boulder Zoning Ordinance Section 202(3)(d) to Clarify the Terms of Office for Planning Commission members.

The public hearing was opened. Judi read the proposed changes to the ordinance. There were no comments. Pete made a motion to close the public hearing. Gladys seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.
