

August 10, 2012

Meeting began at 11:10 a.m.

Present: Bill Muse, Mayor; Gladys LeFevre, Sue Inman, Council Members; Judi Davis, Clerk.

Absent: Tom Jerome and Steve Cox, Council Members.

This special meeting was called to make an adjustment to the fire restrictions imposed in town by the adoption of Ordinance 67. The mayor read the proposed Ordinance 68, An Ordinance Imposing Firework Restrictions. There was some discussion on the restriction on the discharge of firearms, with hunting season approaching. In reviewing the Forest Service's original restrictions, it was decided to add "tracer ammunition" to the list of prohibited uses and to remove the section making the discharge of firearms illegal. Gladys made a motion that we adopt Ordinance 68 as presented with the deletion of Section 4 and with the addition of "tracer ammunition" after pyrotechnic devices. Sue seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

Sue made a motion that the Council go to executive session to discuss personnel and security systems. Gladys seconded the motion. The voting was as follows: Sue-Aye, Bill-Aye, Gladys-Aye.

The Council went to executive session at 11:25 and returned at 11:36, at which time Gladys made a motion that open meeting resume. Sue seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: Bill-Aye, Gladys, Aye, Sue, Aye.

Sue made a motion the meeting adjourn. Gladys seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

The meeting adjourned at 11:36 a.m.
