

ORDINANCE NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PRIMARY ELECTION SYSTEM FOR NOMINATING AND ELECTING CANDIDATES FOR MUNICIPAL OFFICES

Be it ordained by the town of Boulder, Utah:

Section 1. Election for mayor and council members shall be conducted according to the municipal election section of the Utah Code, reference: 20A-9-404(1) and (2).

Section 2. This ordinance provides for the candidates for mayor and council members to be nominated at a primary election if required. A primary election will be held only when the number of candidates filing for an office exceeds twice the number to be elected. The candidates nominated at the primary election plus candidates that were not required to run in the primary are to be placed on the November ballot.

Section 3. All ordinances of this town which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on posting.

Section 5. Passed this 6th day of April, 1995.
