

Meeting Minutes

Board of Adjustment

January 20, 2021

Quorum present: Tina Karlsson, chair; Jabe Beal, vice chair; Ray Gardner, John Veranth, April O’Neal. Clerk Peg Smith. Public present: Korla Eaquinta, Tessa Barkan, Michala Alldredge.
