ORDER OF THE STATE ENGINEER

On Extension of Time Request

For Application to Appropriate Water Number 97-2259 (A73901)

Application to Appropriate Water Number 97-2259 (A73901), in the name of Sarah Langwell, was filed on April 8, 2002, to appropriate 1.73 acre-feet (af) of water from a well located South 1490 feet and East 770 feet from the NW Corner of Section 35, T33S, R4E, SLB&M (8-inch well, 100-500 feet deep). The water is to be used for the irrigation of 0.25 acre from April 1 to October 31; year-round, indoor, domestic requirements of 1.00 equivalent domestic unit; and year-round stockwatering of 10.00 equivalent livestock units (in cattle, horses, or equivalent species). The water is to be used in all or portion(s) of Section 35, T33S, R4E, SLB&M. The application was approved on June 14, 2002, and proof of beneficial use was last due on June 30, 2021.

The applicant has filed for an extension of time within which to file proof with the State Engineer stating that the residence was completed in December of 2020, additional time is needed to finish the project.

Notice of the extension request was published in The Wayne and Garfield County Insider on July 8 and 15, 2021. No protests were received.

Information contained in the file indicates that there has been little or no physical development completed under this application. Approximately 19 years have passed since the application was approved. Approvals are issued with the understanding that the applicant has the means to pursue the proposed project in a timely manner. However, the applicant's affidavit in support of the application may justify reasonable cause for delay.

The applicant is placed on notice that extension requests must comply with the provisions of Section 73-3-12 of the Utah Code which provides that the applicant is to construct works if necessary, apply water to beneficial use, and file proof with the State Engineer OR file a request for an extension of time with the State Engineer on or before the date set for filing proof. The State Engineer is to extend the date set for submitting proof if the applicant shows reasonable and due diligence in completing the appropriation or reasonable cause for delay in completing the appropriation. If the State Engineer finds unreasonable delay or lack of reasonable and due diligence in completing the appropriation, the State Engineer may deny the extension of time; or grant the request in part or upon conditions, including a reduction of the priority of all or part of the application.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** and an extension of time within which to submit proof is **GRANTED** on Application to Appropriate Water Number 97-2259 (A73901) to and including **June 30, 2026**. Future extension requests must comply with the criteria of Utah Code Ann. § 73-

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3-12 and if substantial additional physical development is not made prior to the deadline established by this order, the next request for an extension of time may be denied.

When the work is complete, an Affidavit of Beneficial Use may be submitted by an applicant without hiring a proof professional if it qualifies under statute. An affidavit qualifies if all of the following criteria are met:

- The water right is associated with a residence, either full- or part-time. (NOTE: Any irrigation or stock use on the affidavit must be associated with the residence.)
- The water use is for a quarter acre of irrigation or less.
- The water use is for the watering of ten head of livestock (or equivalent) or less.
- The water use does not include any uses in addition to the three listed above.


It is the applicant's responsibility to maintain a current address with this office and to update ownership of their water right. Please notify this office immediately of any change of address or for assistance in updating ownership. Additionally, if ownership of this water right or the property with which it is associated changes, the records of the Division of Water Rights should be updated. This Order is subject to the provisions of Administrative Rule R655-6-17 of the Division of Water Rights and to Sections 63G-4-302, 63G-4-402, and 73-3-14 of the Utah Code which provide for filing either a Request for Reconsideration with the State Engineer or for judicial review with the appropriate District Court. A Request for Reconsideration must be filed in writing with the State Engineer within 20 days of the date of this Order. The written request shall be filed in-person, by mail, or electronically. If the request is filed electronically it shall be submitted to: waterrights@utah.gov, which is the authorized general email for the Division. However, a Request for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite to filing for judicial review. A petition for judicial review must be filed within 30 days after the date of this Order or, if a Request for Reconsideration has been filed, within 30 days after the date the Request for Reconsideration is denied. A Request for Reconsideration is considered denied when no action is taken 20 days after the Request is filed.
