

Ordinance 2022-3:

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING ELECTRONIC MEETINGS

WHEREAS, The Town of Boulder authorized electronic meetings of the Town Council and Planning Commission by Resolution 2020-2;

WHEREAS, electronic meetings have facilitated participation, discussion, and voting on town business when circumstances made physical presence unsafe or inconvenient;

WHEREAS, electronic meetings have facilitated citizens observing the meetings and making public comments;

WHEREAS, recent revisions to the Utah Open and Public Meetings Act require updating the 2020 resolution;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Boulder Town Council:

Add to Chapter 34 Administrative Town Policies an Electronic Meetings section as follows:

1. The Town Council, the Planning Commission, the Board of Adjustments, and any other body created by Boulder Town may conduct electronic meetings at the discretion of the presiding officer or by majority vote of the members.
2. Electronic meetings shall be conducted in accordance with the requirements of the Utah Open and Public Meetings Act Section 52-4-207.
3. All members present at the anchor location or participating electronically shall be counted for the purposes of establishing a quorum.
4. The notice for any electronic meeting shall indicate the physical anchor location and instructions for how to connect electronically to the meeting.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective upon passage, after any required posting and/or publication has been accomplished according to law.
