

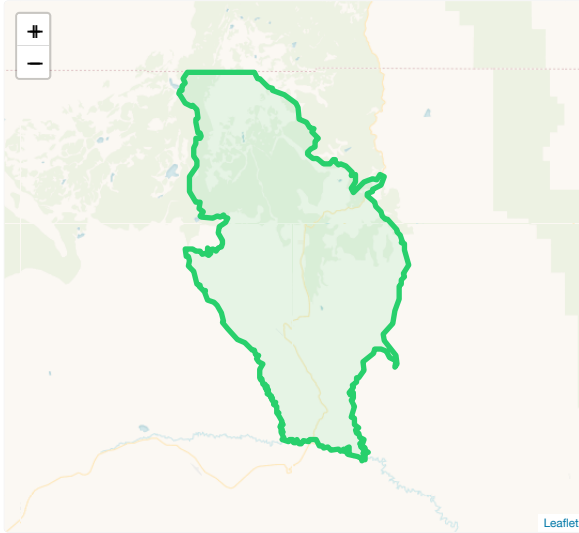

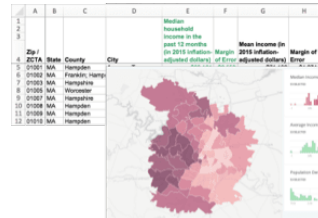
Per-Capita Income
