The water company would like to address the past, recent and continued verbal attack against and towards the company and their employees. There is clearly a misunderstanding the role the water company and the town and its citizens and shareholders.

The water company is owned by its shareholders and operated by the Board of Directors under the directions of the shareholders. The water company provides water to its shareholders and also supplies water to fire hydrant for shareholders and non shareholders fire protection.

The first agreement for fire protection was in 1984 with the town and the water company in which it states that the town is responsible for the maintenance of the fire hydrants in the system. After years of this agreement we both agreed that was beneficial to start a new agreement

Under section 4.3 of the current agreement its states that the water company has no responsibility to install additional fire hydrants or enlarge lines or make other alterations to assist the Town in furnishing fire protection to residents.
